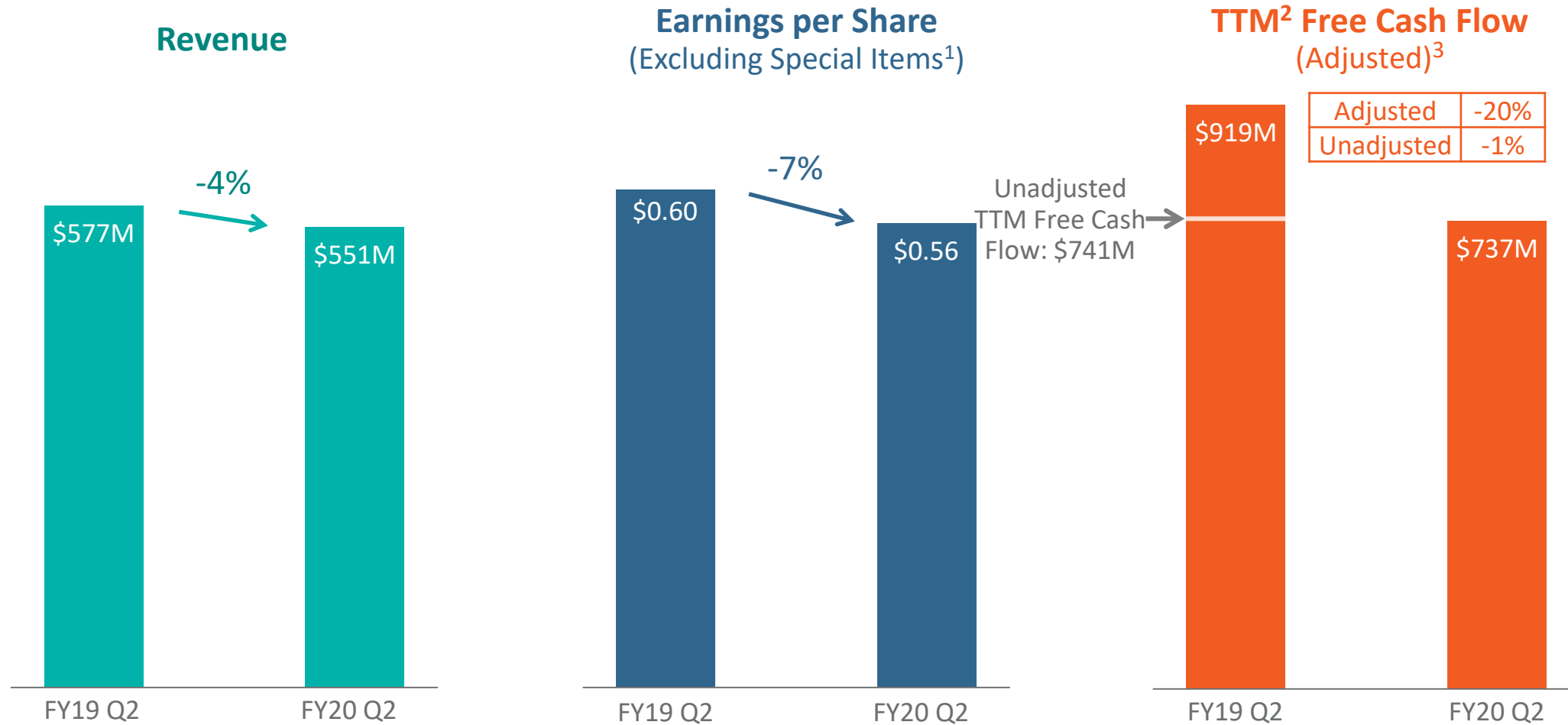

Fiscal 2020 Second Quarter Results vs. Last Year

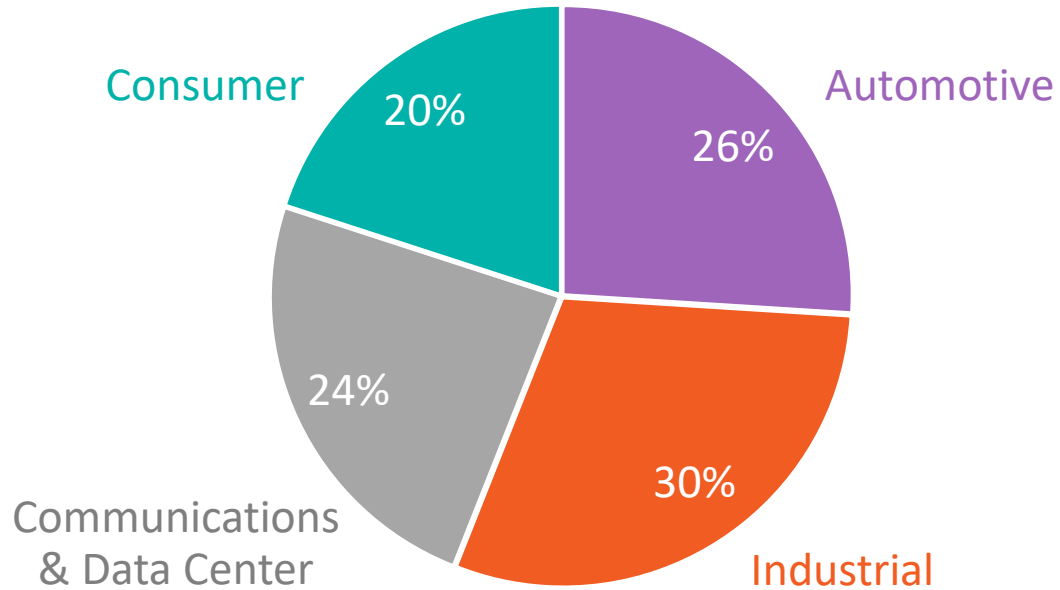


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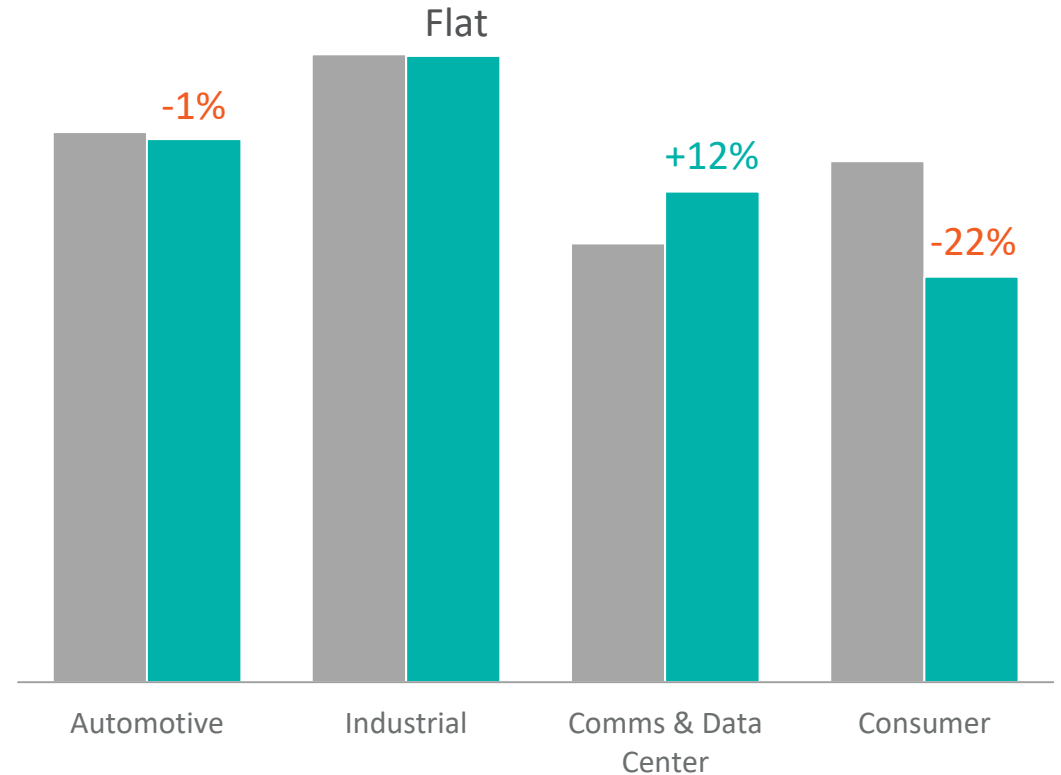

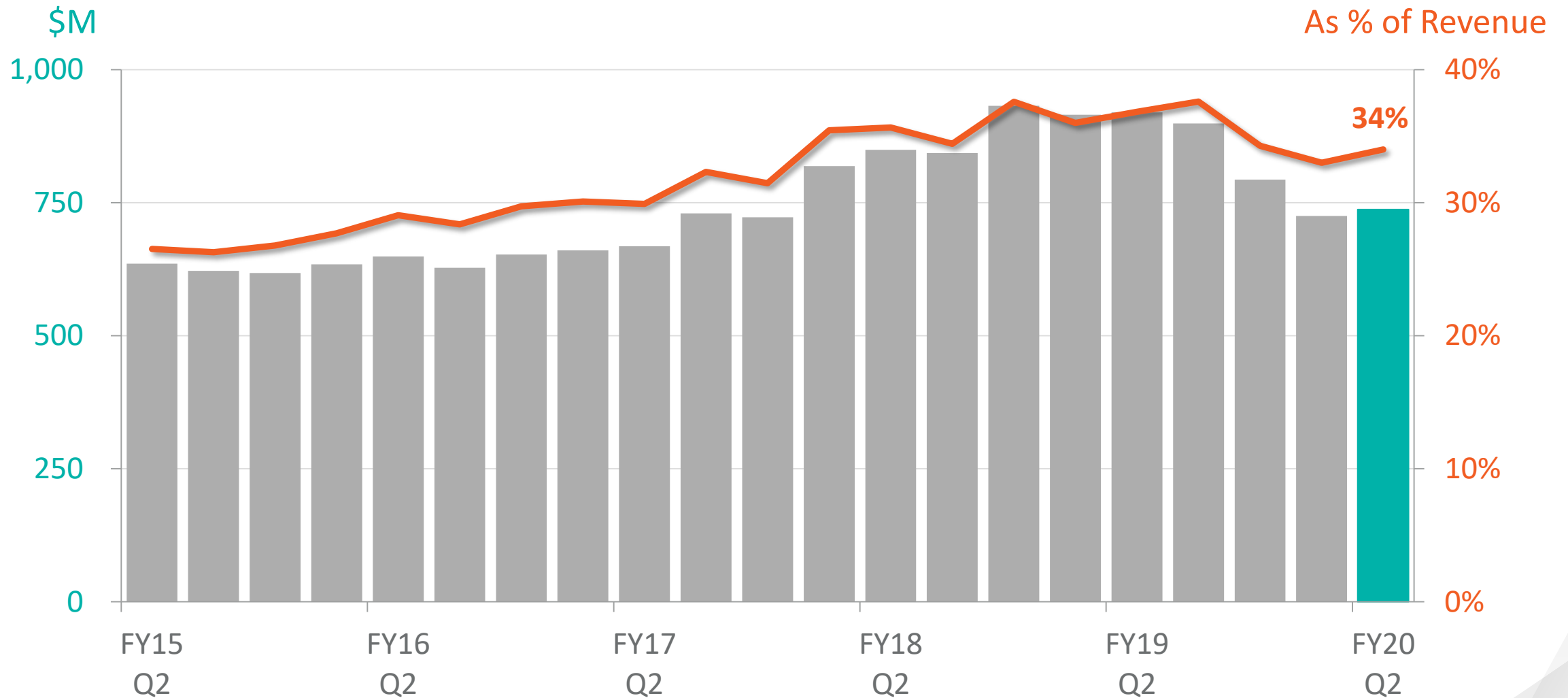

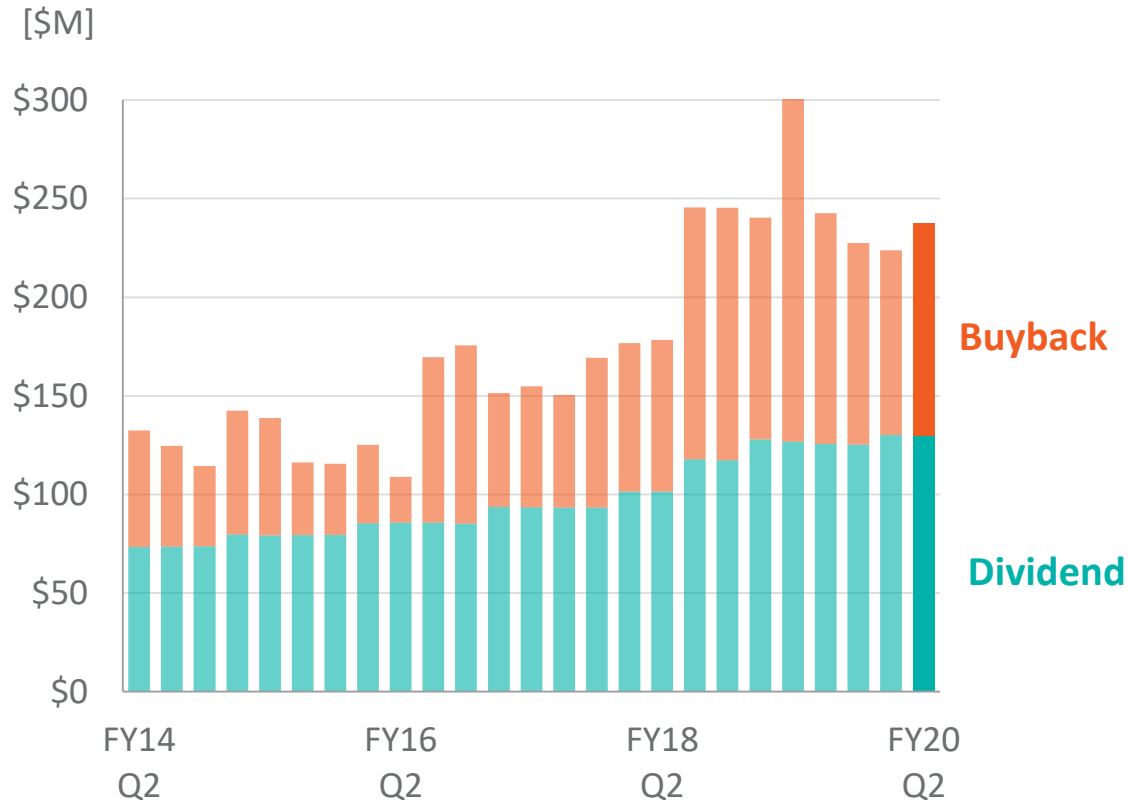


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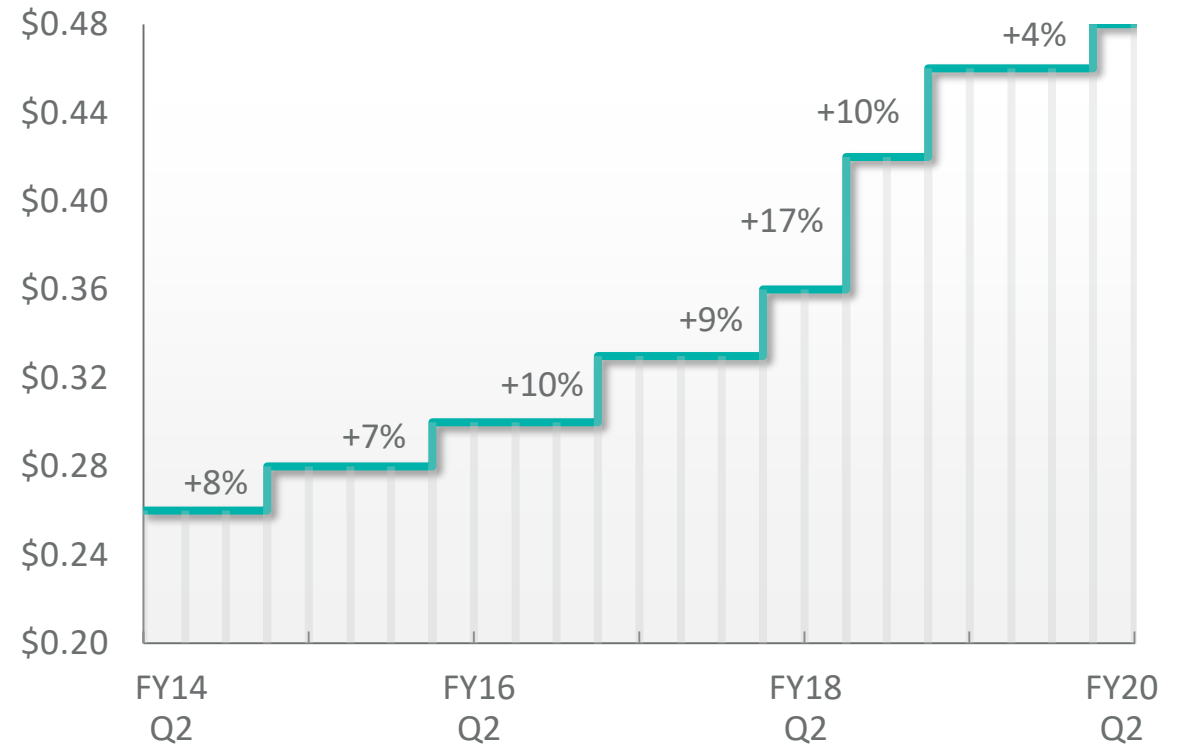
Return of Cash to Shareholders
