Hazardous Materials and Chemical Stewardship Policy

Policy Overview

Universal Display Corporation (the 'Company') maintains an approach to the responsible management of hazardous materials and chemical substances. We recognize that materials' use, emissions, and waste present potential environmental, regulatory, and operational considerations that require oversight and ongoing evaluation.

This policy establishes our approach to managing these materials and chemicals in a manner that supports regulatory compliance, operational integrity, environmental responsibility, and long-term business objectives.

Regulatory Awareness and Compliance

The Company maintains processes designed to support compliance with applicable chemical, environmental, health, and safety regulations in the jurisdictions in which we operate or serve. The Company monitors regulatory developments and evaluates potential implications for its materials, processes, and products, and considers appropriate actions where relevant.

Risk-Based Chemical Stewardship

The Company applies a risk-based approach to the management of hazardous and potentially hazardous substances, prioritizing attention based on regulatory, environmental, operational, and business considerations. This includes maintaining visibility into materials that the Company uses and periodically reviewing substances for relevant considerations.

We recognize that materials used by the Company must meet strict performance standards and customer qualification requirements. Accordingly, any changes to materials or processes are evaluated carefully to maintain product integrity, quality, and reliability.

Hazardous Materials and Chemical Management

The Company maintains an established review process for high-risk hazardous materials and chemicals used at applicable Company sites. This process is conducted by a cross-functional team that evaluates potential risks as part of the materials introduction and approval process. Reviews may consider employee safety, health, environmental, regulatory, and operational factors, as applicable. Where appropriate, the review process may also identify potential material and/or chemical alternatives for further consideration.

Environmental Management

The Company manages emissions, pollutants, and waste with the objective of minimizing environmental impact, where practicable and consistent with operational requirements and applicable regulations. Our approach includes:

- Responsible handling, storage, and disposal of hazardous materials
- Prevention of spills, releases, and uncontrolled emissions
- Use of appropriate waste management, recycling, or disposal practices
- Periodic review of operational processes to identify opportunities for improved efficiency and reduced environmental impact

Performance Monitoring

The Company maintains processes to track and review relevant environmental data associated with its operations, including waste and emissions, where applicable.

We periodically evaluate available data to better understand trends, risks, and potential areas of focus, and may assess the feasibility of enhancing performance indicators over time based on data availability and operational considerations.

Governance and Oversight

The Company maintains governance processes intended to support oversight of chemical-related environmental and regulatory considerations. These include:

- Senior management review of relevant environmental, health, safety, and regulatory matters
- Cross-functional coordination among EHS, Legal, R&D, Operations, and Supply Chain
- Ongoing review of regulatory developments and potential business impacts

The Company continues to evaluate opportunities to enhance governance practices as business needs and expectations evolve.

Supply Chain Expectations

The Company expects suppliers and relevant third parties to manage hazardous materials in accordance with applicable laws and responsible practices.

Where appropriate, the Company may engage with suppliers to support compliance, including with respect to chemical handling, documentation, transportation, and waste management practices.

Continuous Improvement and Transparency

The Company continues to evaluate its approach to hazardous materials management and chemical stewardship over time. This includes consideration of improvements to internal processes, data visibility, and external disclosures, as appropriate.
