Challenges For Otis Elevator – Capacity & Safety

Challenges

- Their freight was not Driver friendly
- Irregular in shape
- Hard to tie down
- Hard to tarp
- While requiring tight delivery windows

Resulting In

- Brokered trucks would not come back
- Unhappy Co. Drivers and Owner Operators that didn't want to haul their freight



Solutions:

- Otis Elevator invested in a tarping station designed to improve the environment for drivers

- Reduction in load and tarp time 150-30 Min
- Improved their safety environment
- Eliminated their exposure to fall accidents
