[Declaration of Compliance with California Health and Safety Code §119402](#)

Nevro Corp. (“Nevro” or “Our” or the “Company”) has adopted a Comprehensive Compliance Program that is in accordance with the United States Department of Health and Human Services Office of Inspector General’s (“OIG”) April 2003 publication, “Compliance Program Guidance for Pharmaceutical Manufacturers” and the Advanced Medical Technology Association’s “Code of Ethics on Interactions with Health Care Professionals” (“AdvaMed Code”).

For the purposes of complying with the California Health and Safety Code §119402, Nevro established an annual spend limit of \$2,500 for items and activities provided to healthcare professionals in California during 2017. This limit is an annual limit, and the amount spent per healthcare professional is anticipated to be less than the maximum amount. As provided for by law, this annual limit does not include the following: payments made for samples given to physicians and healthcare professionals intended for free distribution to patients; financial support for continuing medical education forums; financial support for health educational scholarships provided in compliance with OIG and AdvaMed Code guidance; and payments made for legitimate professional services provided by a health care professional, including but not limited to, consulting services that do not exceed the fair market value of services rendered and ancillary payments made in conformity therewith.

As of July 1, 2017, Nevro is in compliance with both its Comprehensive Compliance Program and California Health and Safety Code §119402 to the best of its knowledge.
