

Abra Group Announces May 2026 Operating Metrics¹

London, United Kingdom – June 19, 2026 – Abra Group transported 5.8 million passengers in May 2026, representing a 5.6% increase compared to May 2025. Year to date, the Group has transported 30.4 million passengers, a 9.1% increase compared to the same period in 2025.

In terms of capacity, Abra Group operated 10.1 billion available seat kilometers (ASKs) during the month, reflecting a 5.9% increase compared to May 2025. On a year-to-date basis, ASKs increased by 6.8% compared to the same period last year, totaling 51.5 billion.

Furthermore, the Group recorded 42.5 thousand departures for the period, a 4.7% increase compared to May 2025. Year to date, departures increased by 6.9% compared to the same period in 2025, reaching 215.9 thousand.

Traffic, measured in revenue passenger kilometers (RPKs), reached 8.0 billion in May 2026, an increase of 7.3% compared to May 2025. Cumulative RPKs for 2026 increased by 10.6% compared to the same period in 2025, totaling 42.1 billion.

Consequently, the Group's load factor was 79.7% for the month, an improvement of 1.0 percentage point compared to May 2025. Year to date, the load factor stood at 81.8%, an improvement of 2.8 percentage points compared to the same period in 2025.

Regarding cargo operations, Abra Group transported 71.6 thousand tons of cargo, indicating a 14.0% increase compared to May 2025. Cumulative transported weight reached 343.4 thousand tons of cargo, a 14.2% increase relative to the same period in 2025.

Glossary

Available Seats Kilometer (ASK).

Available seat kilometers represent aircraft seating capacity multiplied by the number of kilometers the seats are flown.

Revenue Passenger Kilometer (RPK).

Revenue passenger kilometers represent the number of kilometers flown by revenue passengers.

Percentage Point (PP).

The difference between two percentages is termed as percentage point. Percentage point is used to show the changes in an indicator with respect to its previous standings. One percentage point is also equal to 100 basis points.
