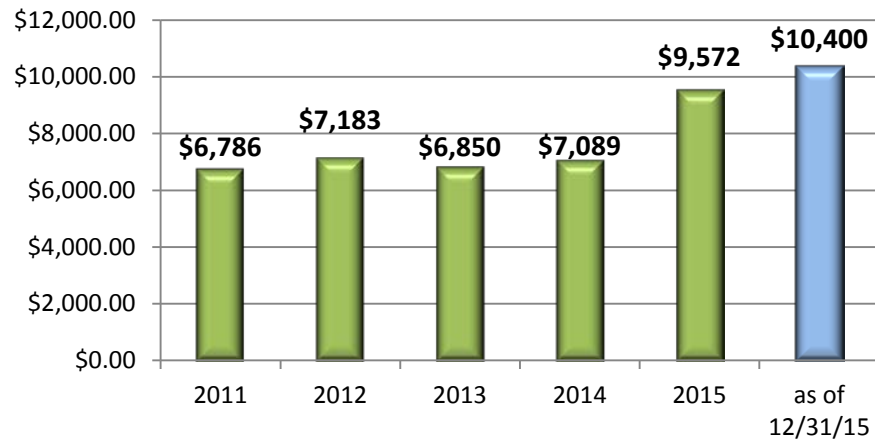
Total Revenue



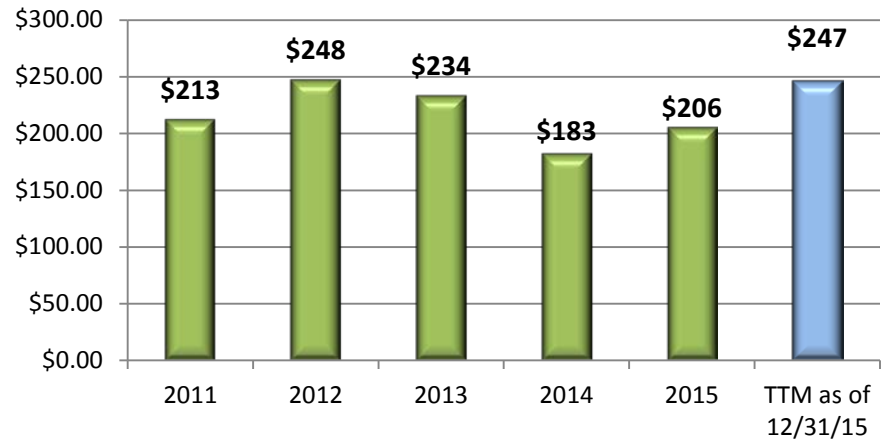
Diluted EPS

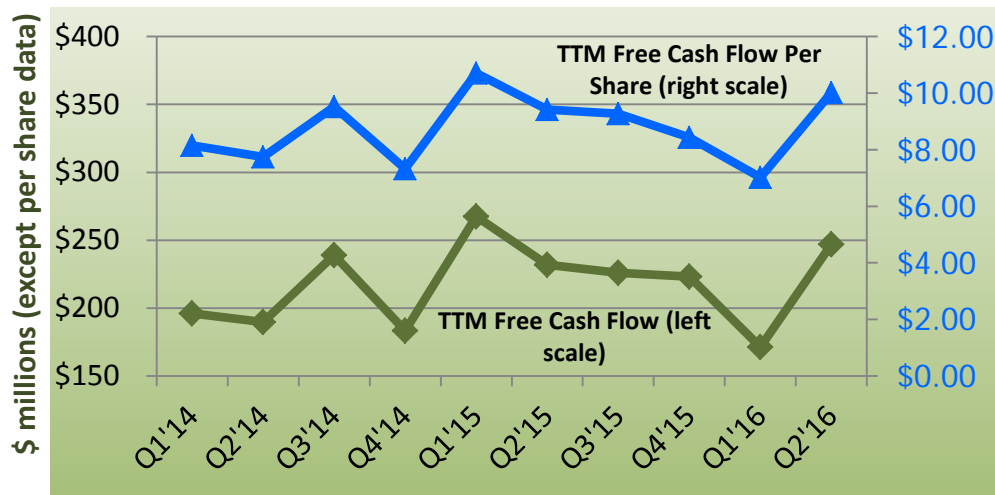
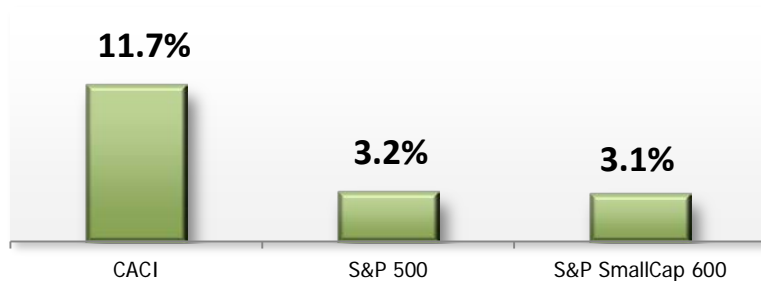

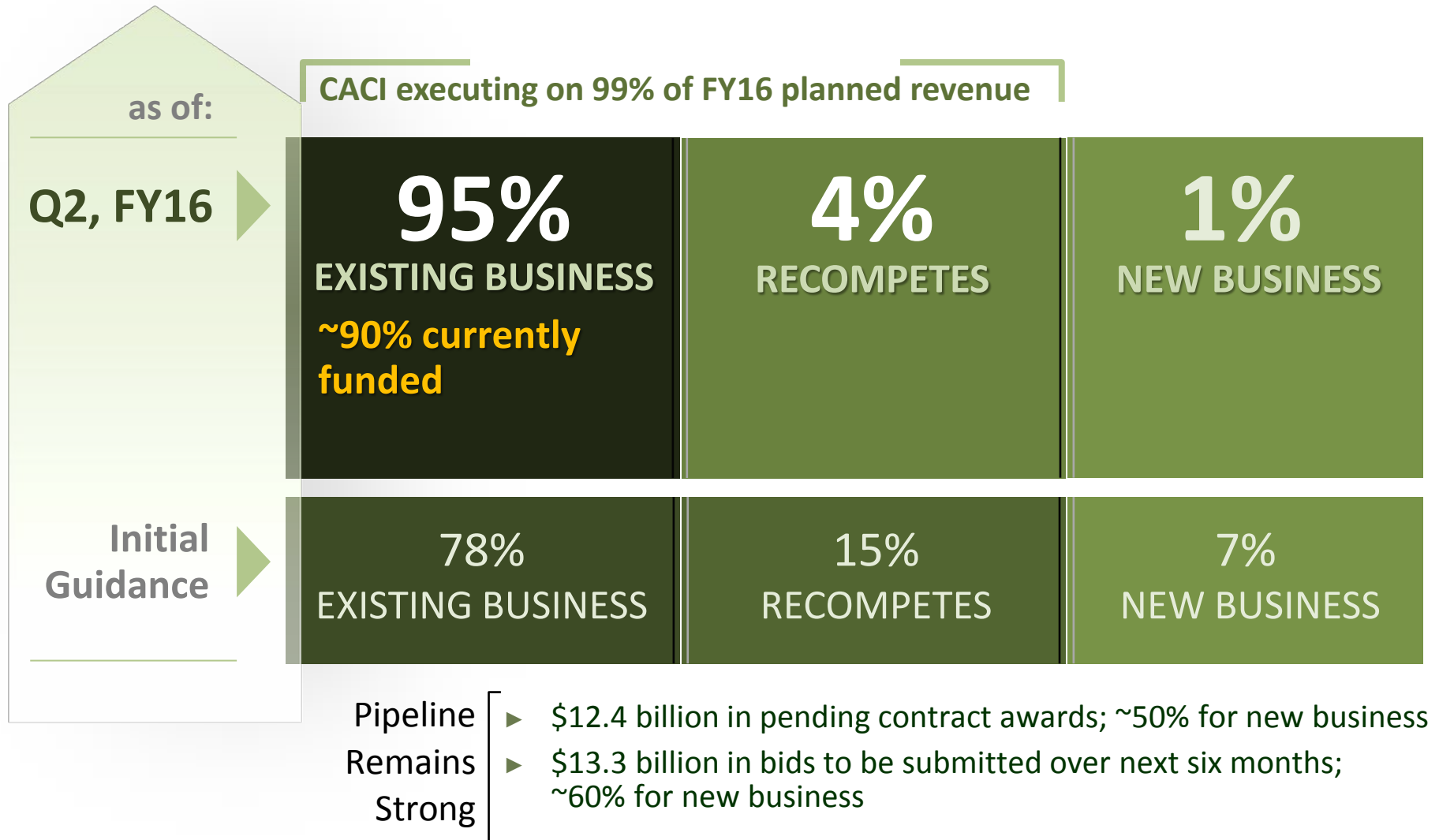

Purchase Price

- \$550 million in cash, which results in a LTM EBITDA¹ multiple of 7.9x after adjusting for the net present value of tax benefits
- Closed February 1, 2016

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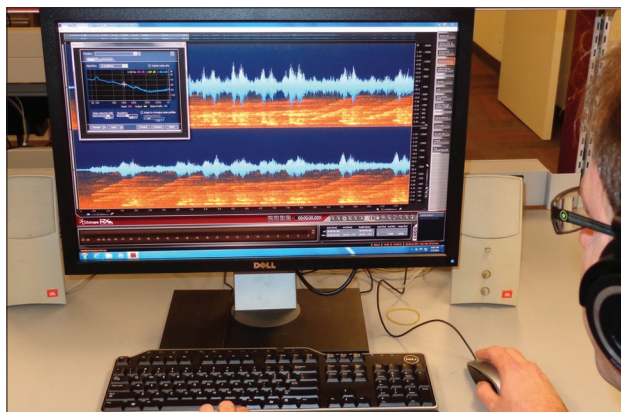
