CACI Awarded \$25 Million Contract to Continue Support for U.S. Air Force Information Operations Training

Company to Help Sustain and Modernize Command and Control Training Solutions Suite

ARLINGTON, Va.--(BUSINESS WIRE)-- CACI International Inc ([NYSE MKT: CACI](#)) announced today that it has been awarded a \$25 million contract to continue its support for the U.S. Air Force Air, Space and Cyberspace Constructive Environment - Information Operations Suite (ACE-IOS) for the 90th Information Operations Squadron of the 24th Air Force and Air Force Cyber Command. The three-year contract represents ongoing work in CACI's [Command and Control](#) market area.
