Mine Support Infrastructure and Plant Site

SAG Mill Foundation & Batch Plant

The grinding circuit remains on the project's critical path and is tracking on schedule, with rebar and formwork in place and ready for concrete placement. On the right, the high-volume concrete batch plant is prepared to support the largest pour of the project.





Dormitory Progress

This image highlights continued progress on the dormitories. As of December, 682 beds are available on site, including Dormitory C3, which is complete and occupied. Another 96 beds will be delivered by the end of January as construction remains on track. The future airstrip is under development in the upper-left corner.



Mine Equipment Assembly

The image on the left shows one of eight HD1500 mining trucks being assembled as part of the initial open-pit mining fleet. On the right, the first PC4000 has been fully assembled, completed in December, and is now entering commissioning in January, with a second unit currently under assembly.





Earthworks Activity – TSF Area

At our Tailing Site Facility, bush clearing has progressed well as we prepare the site for grubbing using our new smaller construction class equipment.



Our Team at Work

Our current workforce of approximately 1,000 contractors and employees are predominately from Guyana, with approximately 600 focused on construction. In this photo they are current building the permanent kitchen and mess hall for employees.



Health & Safety Focused Construction

On the left, our team is assembling a pipe culvert for drainage and water management, while the middle and left photos show our team working on rebar ensuring all safety protocols are followed.



Access Road & Telecommunications Access

Shown on the left is the access road, which ascends toward the communications tower on the right. The 4G/LTE Oko West Communications Tower is an essential element of our broader IT infrastructure, enabling robust connectivity throughout the site.



Wharf Landing

Itaballi Landing & Wooden Wharf

We commissioned the wooden wharf dock in the middle of the photo as part of our social investment projects. We are currently using it for the transport of contractors, employees and visitors, but was built to improve river access, enhance safety, and facilitate the movement of people and goods, for the community.



GMIN Toucan Speedboat

On January 23, 2026, the GMIN Toucan, a 50-passenger speedboat, made its maiden voyage from Parika to Itaballi, Region Seven, enhancing safe, efficient, and reliable transportation of people to Oko West.
