



Shaft Engineer

Ascendant Resources is currently seeking a Shaft Engineer at our El Mochito mine located in west-central Honduras. The successful candidate The position will ensure the management and coordination of all engineering activities associated to the entire shaft infrastructures, including shaft barrel and winders ensuring that the legal responsibility, as required by statutory requirements are adhered to which includes but not limited to the responsibilities listed below.

Responsibilities

- Implement and coordinate safe and efficient hoisting procedures to attain scheduled production tonnage at minimum cost.
- Implement standard operating methods and safety procedures in compliance with plant and government mine regulations.
- In conjunction with the shaft supervisor, schedule and coordinate the maintenance and associated downtime required for hoisting and lowering of people and materials of shaft facilities and hoists in a manner that will ensure uninterrupted production to both the mine operations and the surface concentrator.
- Working with the shop supervisor, schedule and coordinate the activities related to the main shop.
- Evaluate and recommend the purchase of additional or replacement shaft equipment necessary to achieve the mine plan.
- Coordinate, identify and recommend shutdown work to ensure efficient operation of all shaft area equipment.
- Plan and implement predictive and preventive maintenance strategies and techniques, to ensure that the Hoist Plant Asset condition is maintained at high standard and in compliance with applicable regulations.
- Actively lead and develop hoist supervisors and shop supervisors.
- Participate in the development of the mine capital and profit plans.
- Budget and cost control; SHERQ adherence and compliance.
- Implement change initiatives and engineer operations process and systems.

Requirements

- Bachelor's Degree in Engineering, majoring in Mechanical or Electrical Engineering.
- Minimum 10 years of experience in the management and maintenance of winders and vertical shaft including extensive Knowledge of shaft maintenance and hoisting plant operation.
