

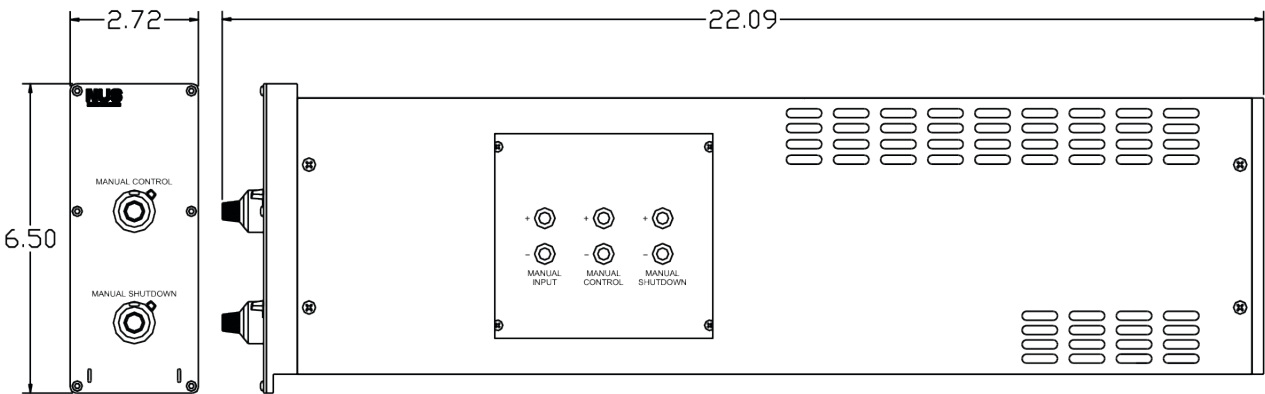
SET700 Setpoint Station

The SET700 Setpoint Station provides a replacement for Foxboro externally-referenced setpoint stations. The SET700 is a manual station that accepts an external reference voltage labeled "Manual Input". With two precision pots, the SET700 produces two setpoint signals proportional to the Manual Input.

The setpoint signals are labeled "Manual Control" and "Manual Shutdown". Both front panel pots are equipped with counting dials. Test jacks for measuring Manual Input, Manual Control, and Manual Shutdown are on the right side of the Setpoint Station.
