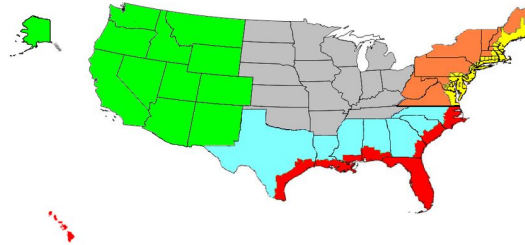

The comparable GAAP measure is the ratio of debt to total capital.
