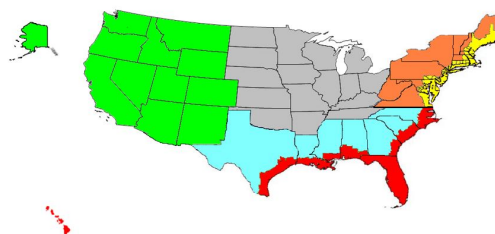

Excludes the impact of changes in foreign currency exchange rates used in the translation of the income statement because they can be volatile.
